Do you sleep well every night? Sleeping well is very important for junior high school students. First, they are still growing. Their bodies and brains are developing. When they don't sleep well, their bodies don't make enough *growth hormones. (1)<u>They</u> are needed for our healthy growth, so enough sleep is important to grow up well. Second, sleep plays an important role in *learning and memory. When junior high school students sleep well, they can *maintain better *cognitive function and *improve *academic performance. That means that studying through the night may not be good. Last, sleeping well reduces stress. Junior high school students may feel some stress from their school and daily life (A) doing a lot of homework and *quarreling with their friends. Then, they should go to bed earlier and have enough sleep. Sleeping well is good for these points.

Last week, I asked 200 students in our junior high school, "What time do you usually go to bed?" and "Why do you usually go to bed that time?" Table 1 shows the results of my first question and Table 2 shows the results of my second question. In Table 1, "From 11:00 to 11:59" is the most popular answer. It is thirty percent. Only two percent of the students go to bed before 9:00. This was surprising because forty-four students go to bed at 0:00 and after. I think that they should go to bed earlier to have enough sleep. Next, Table 2 shows that the percentage of "Play a video game" is as much as the percentage of "Watch videos on the Internet." Thirty-two students answered "Study" and "Read a book" is the most popular.

According to a *study, junior high school student's *adequate sleeping time is 8 to 10 hours. Sleeping is necessary *even after students become *adults. I believe that starting to think about sleep now is important for our lives.
